- Shin pads and running shoes are required.
- Player evaluations are not required.
- OMSA will host a mini fest wrap up event for teams at the end of the season.

- Registration fees include a player jersey, shorts, socks, ball, team photo and medal.
- Program includes pre season fun camp & “Kickers” academy skills throughout the season.
- Shin pads and running shoes are required.
- Player evaluations are not required.
- OMSA will host a mini fest wrap up event for teams at the end of the season.
- Practice/games take place at Howard Park and or the Track Field.

OMSA COMMUNITY HOUSE LEAGUE: Recreational U10 & U12 Programs

- The season is Apr 30th to June 23rd, 2012.
- Games/practices are played in Okotoks.
- 3 hours per week
- U10 play 7 players per side (7v7) with a designated keeper.
- U12 play 8 players per side (8v8) with a designated keeper.
- Program includes pre season tune up & “World Cup” academy skills throughout the season.
- Registration fees include a player jersey, shorts, socks, **ball**, team photo and medal.
- Shin pads and outdoor soccer shoes are required.
- Player evaluations are not required.
- OMSA will host a mini fest wrap up event & tournament for teams at the end of the season.

CMSA U10 Developmental City League

- The season is end of April 2012 to end of June 2012.
- The league is organized by Calgary Minor Soccer (CMSA).
- Home Games are played in Okotoks and away games are played in Calgary.
- We provide an Okotoks jersey (deposit required) and registration fee includes shorts and socks.
- Shin pads and soccer cleats are mandatory.
- Players must attend tryouts. Date **TBA**.
- Game days of play as set by CMSA. Days to be announced end of January.
- One training session a week. Date dependent on field and coach availability.
- Mandatory Academy training (Tech training) for Tier A/B teams. Optional for Tier C.
- All U10 games are scored with a 1 goal difference.

All U10 teams are automatically entered into the Outdoor City Finals at the end of the season

CMSA U12 – U18 Competitive Programs

- Season starts end of Apr 2012.
- Season end dates depend on level of play.
- The league is organized by Calgary Minor Soccer (CMSA).
- Home games are played in Okotoks. Away games are played in Calgary.
- We provide an Okotoks jersey (deposit required) and registration fee includes shorts and socks.
- Shin pads and indoor soccer shoes are mandatory.
- Players hoping to be placed on a Tier I-IV team must attend evaluations. **Date TBA**.
- Games days of play are set by CMSA – to be announced by CMSA at the end of January.
- Training day is dependent on field and coach availability.
- Mandatory Academy training (tech training) for Tiers I-IV. Optional for Tier V-VI.
- Post season play depends on level of play – to be announced by CMSA at the end of January.
