OUTSTANDING REGISTRATION FEES

All outstanding Registration, Academy & SAQ fees must be paid prior to registering for the current season. Payment in full must be received (or arrangements made) before player registrations will be considered complete. Players with outstanding fees will not be permitted to participate in evaluations or placed on team rosters.

REFUNDS

Refunds will be issued less an administration fee of **\$100.00** (CMSA competitive teams) & **\$25.00** (OMSA House League teams) up to the CMSA Team Entry Deadline or player attendance at tryouts, **NO REFUNDS** will be issued unless the request is accompanied by a doctor's note. In the event a player suffers a season ending injury a refund will be prorated based on the date of the physician's note or the date of the request.

Technical training fees are non-refundable after the CMSA Team Entry Deadline Date.

All requests for refunds must be submitted to the OMSA office in writing or by e-mail to: omsaprograms@shaw.ca. Requests can also be mailed to Box 472, Okotoks Alberta, T1S 1A7 or faxed to 403-982-2200. Refund requests made by phone will not be accepted. Pending player registrations on waiting lists will receive a full refund if they are not placed on a team.

BUDGET PAYMENTS AND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

OMSA works closely with families to ensure that soccer is made available to everyone. Those in need of special financial arrangements may select "CASH OR CHEQUE" under payment options and contact the office to make a schedule of payment. ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND WAIVER

The parent and/or guardian of the named player registrant accept the liability and risk associated with soccer as a contact sport and release OMSA, its directors, coaches, employees, agents, and volunteers from any claim, demands, damages, actions or causes of action arising out of or in consequence of any loss, injury or damage to the player incurred while participating in any soccer games, practice, tournament or other event approved by OMSA, regardless of whether or not such loss, injury or damage arises by reason of any negligence of OMSA, its directors, coaches, employees, agents or volunteers.

The parent and/or guardian agrees to indemnify OMSA, its directors, coaches, employees, agents and volunteers (the "Indemnities") from any claims or demands which might be made against the Indemnities arising out of loss, injury or damage mentioned above.

PRIVACY AUTHORIZATION

I understand the Okotoks Minor Soccer Association:

- a. The use of registered player/parent/guardian personal information for player identification purposes and related soccer activities.
- b. The use of registrant's name and related health information to assist authorized parties responding to emergency situations requiring medical and/or other health situations.
- c. The use of registrant's name and personal contact information for the purpose of recruiting volunteer assistance to support various team/OMSA activities and sanctioned events.
- d. The use of photos/videos provided by OMSA members to support educational, newsletter, and website communication purposes.
- e. Does not disclose personal information to any third parties or for any commercial purpose.

On behalf of my child, and myself I consent to allow OMSA to collect, use and disclose personal information for its operational and administrative purposes as described above.

IMPORTANT NOTE ON SPECIAL REQUESTS:

All players will be registered in their own age group according to the year of their birth. Special requests for placements should be noted in program options during on-line registration.
